- Tuition and registration fees
- Accommodation
- Prescribed study material
- Quarterly stipend
- Assistive devices (to enhance learning) for those with disabilities

## Must submit:

- A completed SIOC-CDT Bursary Application Form.
- A certified copy of latest matric results including mid-year Grade 12 results, or latest university/college academic results where application is for funding 2nd year onwards.
- Proof of acceptance at a recognised public Higher Education Institution (University/TVET/FET College).
- A one-page cover letter to motivate your case for financial need.
- A certified copy of your South African ID.
- Proof of residence.
- Proof of combined income of parent(s) or guardian(s) or affidavit where there is no income; and
- Relevant medical note in the case of a disability.

- admitted at the relevant Public Higher Education Institution for 2023 academic year
- in financial need to fund under/postgraduate study with preference given to undergraduates, and
- Preference will be given to people living with disabilities.
