













Access for Success (A4S) is a university preparatory programme presented by the Academy for Environmental Leadership SA (AEL) at Duin in die Weg Campus, Gariep, Northern Cape.

This programme offers Grade 12 learners a second opportunity to improve their Mathematics and Science marks in order to qualify for admission into institutions of Higher Learning in the Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) study field.

SIOC-CDT offers funding support to students from its **five beneficiary areas** of Gamagara, Ga-Segonyana, Joe Morolong, Tsantsabane in the Northern Cape and Thabazimbi area in Limpopo.

DURATION AND TEACHING METHOD:

- Access for Success is a one-year focussed programme.
- Students receive ten (10) hours of tuition, Mondays to Saturdays.
- Classes are presented in **English**.

SUBJECTS OFFERED:

The programme's core focus is Mathematics and Physical Sciences.

In addition, the programme offers the complementary subjects listed below to students as part of their year-long university preparation:

- Fundamentals of Engineering Graphics and Design;
- Personal and interpersonal leadership;
- Basic financial and administrative literacy;
- · Computer and internet literacy; and
- Fundamentals of responsible environmental practices.



METHOD OF ASSESSMENT:

Students only re-write the National Senior Certificate Examination in Mathematics and Physical Sciences. Complementary subjects are presented and assessed by the AEL.

ADDITIONAL STUDENT ASSISTANCE:

The programme further assists students in **career guidance and the processing of university and bursary applications**. Students may apply for admission to the Cape Peninsula University of Technology or any other Institution of Higher Learning. The AEL, however, cannot guarantee placement in any institution.

Entry requirements

Prospective students should:

- have been in **Grade 12 in the year preceding** the year of application;
- have **passed at least four subjects** from the group of subjects designated for university admission;
- have passed the National Senior Certificate with at least 40% for Mathematics;
- have passed the National Senior Certificate with at least 40% for Physical Sciences;
- have passed the National Senior Certificate with at least 50% for English;
- have passed the National Senior Certificate with at least a **50% average** (excluding Life Orientation). No students with mathematical literacy will be accepted; and
- reside or originate from any of the SIOC-CDT beneficiary areas.

HOW TO APPLY

Only complete applications with copies of the supporting documents listed below will be considered. Please write the applicant's name and surname on all supporting documentation.

Supporting documents required:

- Copies of applicant's **identity document/** birth certificate as proof of SA citizenship;
- Applicant's Gr 11 final school report; and
- National Senior Certificate (NSC). The NSC is an absolute requirement to register as a student. A preliminary application can be submitted until the National Senior Certificate becomes available.
