

GA-SEGONYANA COMMUNITY REPRESENTATIVE TRUSTEE ELECTION

CAMPAIGN GUIDELINES

- 1. Candidates are allowed to launch their own campaigns.
- 2. The use of SIOC-CDT logo by contesting candidates or their campaigners is prohibited and any candidate who transgresses on this rule will be subjected to due processes.
- 3. No campaigning will be allowed within the voting stations demarcated area on election days.
- 4. Candidate representatives are not allowed to wear party political attire, social clubs\movements and organizational or campaigns regalia at the voting stations, including those of unions or respective churches.
- 5. Candidates have a responsibility to monitor and regulate information distributed by their campaign managers.
- 6. Campaigns must be conducted within the parameters of the law, no launch of an attack on other candidates.
- Communication between candidates and IEFSA presiding officers will be done in writing.
- 8. Candidate representatives are not permitted to interact with voters and not allowed to interfere with any processes during elections.
- 9. Candidate representatives have a primary responsibility to observe voting and to alert the Presiding Officer of any violation of electoral rules in the voting station.
- 10. Any dissatisfaction and / or complaint must be addressed with the Presiding Officer in writing and if not resolved, be reported in writing to the Chief Electoral Officer: <u>sioc.elections@gmail.com</u>
